

First Satanic ritual to take place in a publicly owned building in the USA

On Thursday night, October 21st, members of America Needs Fatima gathered in front of the Civic Center in Oklahoma City, OK, to say the Rosary, sing hymns, and pray to Saint Michael the Archangel to counter the first Satanic ritual to take place in a publicly owned building in the USA.

While Catholics prayed outside the Civic Center, a group called the "Church of the IV Crowned Princes" was performing a Satanic ritual inside the Civic Center, a type of exorcism, with the expressed intent to poke fun at the Catholic Church. This amounts to government-endorsed, -sponsored, and -enabled, ridicule of the Catholic Faith.

Members of America Needs Fatima from Oklahoma, Kansas, Texas and Arkansas came to pray against the Satanic ritual. Our group held signs such as: "Honk if you love Jesus!" and "St. Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle."

Our large banner read:

"As Catholics, we ask the Blessed Virgin Mary to crush the Serpent's head and to protect America from all Satanic influence."

James Hale, the leader of the Satanic sect, said his group is doing the Satanic ritual to try to bring Satanism into the mainstream. "We just decided that being right here in the middle of the Bible Belt, it wasn't a good idea to keep the secrecy you see in the traditional Satanist churches. Because secrecy breeds fear. And we're not looking to scare anyone."

Francis Slobodnik, who led the America Needs Fatima Rosary Rally against the Satanic ritual said: "Satan is the eternal enemy of God. This Satanic ritual is the worst thing that could have happened to Oklahoma City. It means a new step in the process of accepting evil and Satan in America. Will God bless us if we accept Satanism?"

"That's why we felt obligated to come out here and show our prayerful opposition," said Slobodnik. "More importantly, we're here to say the Virgin Mary is She who crushed the head of Satan."

There's still time to send a message of protest against this Satanic ritual to the Mayor of Oklahoma City, Mr. Cornett.

The great apostle of the Marian devotion, Saint Louis Grignion de Montfort, in his celebrated book A Treatise on the True Devotion to the Blessed Virgin, explains the unique role of Mary in the fight against Satan:

That enmity is between Mary, his worthy Mother, and the devil, between the children and the servants of the Blessed Virgin and the children and followers of Lucifer.
